
PUBLIC NOTICE

Public Consultation for setting a mandatory frequency zone for Montmagny and Isle-aux-Grues airports

Transport Canada wants your feedback about creating a mandatory frequency (MF) zone for the Montmagny and Isle-aux-Grues airports. If this zone is set, only radio-equipped aircraft can fly in the zone.

Transport Canada wants to create this zone due to the increase in commuter air traffic between the two airports, in accordance with Part VI, Subpart 2, Division V – "Operations at or in the Vicinity of an Aerodrome" of the Canadian Aviation Regulations.

The zone from the surface up to 1,500 feet above-sea-level would extend to a radius of 5 nautical miles around both the Isle-aux-Grues and Montmagny airports, and end at Highway 20.
